

Chewack Wildfire

Things to Bring to Fire – Pack Compact

Provided: Hardhat, Gloves, Eye Protection, Nomex, Web Gear, Headlamp, Fire Shelter. (Any of these items you can bring if you want to)

- Work Boots: No Steel Toe, Break Them In. **Extra Boot Laces.**
- **You will usually leave the following items in fire camp, while out on fire.**
- Boot Grease: non-petroleum base. Snowseal, Whites or Obermans.
- 2nd set of leather work gloves.
- Foot Powder: Antifungal.
- 2nd set of Nomex is recommended. You may need to buy.
- **Clothing for up to 14 days:** socks (anti-blister, non-itch toe, wool blend or cotton), underwear, warm coat, sweatshirt, evening attire, slippers, ball cap, shorts or cutoffs, t-shirts.
- Plastic garbage bag for raingear or bringing dirty laundry home.
- Towel and washcloth.
- Bar of soap.
- Personal tent.
- Sleeping bag and pillow; it does get cold at night.
- Sleeping pad, small cot or small blow-up mattress.
- Ear plugs.
- Flash light or small lantern.
- Handkerchief or bandana.
- **Personal Items Kit:** Tooth paste and brush, floss, meds(prescription and over the counter aspirin, Tylenol, Advil) Chap-stick, foot powder, antifungal cream(Lotrimin), poison oak cream, sunscreen, polysporin, Band-aids, moleskin (fabric used to protect feet), medicated hand lotion, Tucks medicated pads, comb, deodorant, shampoo, nail clippers, small sewing kit.
- Mosquito repellent.
- Sunglasses.
- Alarm clock.
- Pocket knife or Leatherman.
- Matches.
- Toilet paper.
- Hand wash, hand sanitizer.
- Reading material.
- Frisbee, football or hackysack.
- Cash (\$100), credit card or debit card.
- The fire will provide meals but bring snacks, power-bar and bottled water.
- Cell phone with charger. Minimize phone use on fireline.
- Eye glasses or contacts with wash, if needed.
- Personal electronics, for traveling.
- Pocket notebook and pen.
- Fireline handbook, IRPG.
- Taskbook.
